The academic programs listed above are designed to meet the educational requirements for specific licensing or certification exams required for employment in specific occupations. The programs offered by LCU are designed to meet the educational requirements for licensing or certification in the state of Texas specifically, although they may meet requirements in other states as well.

If, at the time application to a program listed above, a prospective student is located in a state other than Texas, LCU will notify the applicant of the status of the program with regard to the requirements in that state before the prospective student enrolls in the

program. The home address on the admissions application will be used to determine student location. Students in educator certification programs will also be asked to disclose intention to seek certification in a state other than Texas before enrolling in the program.

If LCU is unable to determine whether a program meets the educational requirements for a specific state, the applicant will be provided with contact information for licensing or certification in the state as required by state authorization and reciprocity agreements (NC-SARA).
